

FORMATION OF TERRITORIAL-INVESTMENT ENVIRONMENT IN LAND DISTRIBUTION

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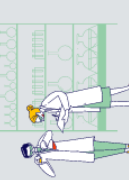
Abstract

This article is dedicated to the development of scientifically-practically based proposals and recommendations on ways to attract domestic and foreign investments to economic sectors through the rational and effective distribution of land, which is one of the most urgent issues of today, and on the formation of a regional investment environment in this regard.

Introduction

The efficient and reasonable use of our country's land fund is of great socio-economic importance from the point of view of solving strategic objectives and tasks related to the development and liberalization of the economy. After all, the prospects for the development of all sectors of the economy of the republic, business and entrepreneurship, social sectors are closely linked to the use of land funds and its level. This requires the redistribution of land between their categories, tomatoes and land users from the point of view of meeting the needs of the state and society, based on the objective requirements of socio-economic development. Otherwise, by improving socio-economic development and improving the investment environment, we need to actively attract foreign investment to the networks and regions of our country's economy. ✚ Long-term lease of land not intended for agriculture for up to 50 years, but not less than specified in the application.

✚ Auction sale of the right to permanent ownership of land for the construction of real estate properties.

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Additionally, in the years that followed, efforts are being made to improve the country's investment processes, establish the order in which government development programs are developed, improve the transparency and efficiency of project selection, and finance them. At the same time, all components of the new arrangement for the development of government development programs have just begun, approved, as well as large-scale and strategically important investment projects to be developed this year, especially the lack of harmonization of their duration with the implementation of such projects involving direct foreign investment, bringing them to an end in a timely manner, increasing production capacity, producing products creates investment and financial concerns to start issuing and creating new jobs.

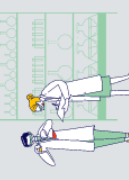

- ❖ the use of incentives for rational use of land (as well as penalties).

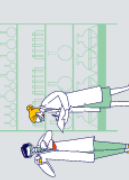
In doing the following, of course, we work in unconditioned connection with land laws and laws, and these laws must be comprehensive in all respects.
