In France, preschool education is called the "school of mothers". The main goal of this is to bring the students closer to home conditions, to form warm family-like relationships, and to prepare them for teaching at school. A school preparation group for 5-6-year-old children is organized and the coverage rate is 100 percent. In French schools, great emphasis was placed on the education of sophistication. Pupils' confidence in their own strength, ability and potential is nurtured.

Preschool education in the United States covers children between the ages of 3 and 5. The US educational system is one of the most developed in the world. After the pre-primary education system, children receive education in elementary schools. In these schools, one teacher teaches all subjects. Thorough knowledge is provided in the subjects of art, fine arts, music, reading, physical education, natural science, geography, and history. The peculiarity of the US education system is that students are given thorough knowledge from pre-school education. Because children sent to elementary school are divided into classes by taking a test. The results of this test are divided into groups A, B, and C, i.e., "talented", "normal", and "incompetent" and graded knowledge is given. Higher education universities in the USA occupy leading positions in the world. America's greatest asset is intelligence. Tests for admission to American



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higher education institutions: ETS (Educational Testing Service), TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) I, SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) II, GRE (Graduate Record Examinations) General Test, GRE (Graduate Record Examinations) Subject Test, ACT (American College Testing), GMAT (Graduate Grade), GPA (Grade Point Average).
