Nowadays, various Internet sites have a negative impact on the minds of young people, but the number of people who are addicted to them is increasing every day. Such a psychological connection leads to tragic consequences. Some young people are engaged in various games in computer clubs. According to experts, 49 percent of computer games distributed via the Internet contain a significant amount of violence and cruelty. In 41 percent of war games, the hero of the game commits such violence or cruelty to achieve his goal. In 17 percent of games, this violence and cruelty itself is the main goal. We cannot say that various warlike games that do not suit our mentality, and sometimes heroism turns into barbarity, can have a positive impact on the moral and aesthetic education of our children. Although at first glance they may seem like ordinary games, there are many real-life examples of how the ideas of violence and the awakening of a mood of cruelty have led to many negative consequences [2].
