Social partnership and collaboration make it possible, with the support of civil society institutions and social partners, to implement the reforms implemented in society transparently and to understand them correctly for every member of society.

As we have already mentioned, the social partnership environment focused on social cooperation is the force that improves and guides social partnership and cooperation in the country. From this point of view, given that the way of life and well-being of citizens primarily depends on the quality and effectiveness of the reforms implemented in the country, it is very important to create a legal basis for the establishment of social partnership.

The initiatives proposed in the Concept require raising the activities of such organizations to a new level, organizing activities of various non-governmental non-profit organizations and organizing clearly targeted activities. Currently, the public fund under the Oliy Majlis provides grants, subsidies and grants to non-governmental non-profit organizations from the state budget, but non-governmental organizations and other civil society institutions should not only rely on government support, but should also include others in the legislation make effective use of the mechanisms provided. Today, it is desirable for the National Association of Non-Governmental Non-Commercial Organizations of Uzbekistan and other large non-governmental organizations to expand the scope of their activities, to make them effective organizations, that is, to work on innovative ideas and projects that are acceptable to a wide range of people are. This is particularly relevant for a number of civil society institutions, such as the Confederation of Trade Unions of Uzbekistan, the Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the Women's Committee and the Farmers' Association. The Law “On Social Partnership” opens up many opportunities for such organizations. It is desirable that this draft law be discussed publicly and covered in the mass media [3]. At the current stage of our country's development, we must, without exaggeration, strengthen the role of non-governmental organizations and

other civil society institutions, democratize our country, integrate it into the world community, ensure national and interreligious harmony and stability in our society and the implementation of the principle “From a strong state to a strong civil society” becomes the decisive factor in achieving the set goals [4]. It is recognized that the social sphere and its aspects are always relevant in relation to other sectors of society. The creation of a new legal environment for the construction and development of social partnership in society is the basis for creating concrete conditions for strengthening social partnership of citizens. On the other hand, it should be noted that the creation of social conditions and legal foundations for people is considered an important criterion of civil society.

In short, the establishment of a social partnership between non-governmental and non-profit organizations and state structures on the basis of the law makes a significant contribution to the work of democratic renewal, the creation of a civil society and a legal democratic state in our society.
