Introduction

Nowadays, the use of English language capabilities in order to improve the quality of education has become one of the most widespread methodological tools. In it, special courses were organized to improve the knowledge and skills of teachers in working with students and students. These courses mainly provided opportunities for the use of computer simulation models in teaching and the widespread use of modern technological devices in English education. In recent years, the use of new information technologies in teaching foreign languages has become a matter of great importance. The main goal of teaching English is to learn practical skills in

This includes not only remembering and pronouncing words correctly, but also knowing where and how to use them. An editor (Latin - arranged) is a software system that works with computer objects (text, tables, graphics, programs).

The group of programs that prepare text documents is mainly divided into two: text editors and word processors.

Text editors are programs that prepare text files without using formatting elements. Formatting elements are understood as the fact that parts of the text are not separated by different fonts, etc. Such editors are mainly used to create text for computer programs.

Word processors are programs that allow you to format text, place graphics and other objects in a document.

Some word processors are called WYSIWYG - editors. This means What You See Is What You Get - what you see is what you get. In other words, the way you see a document on a computer screen is the same way you see it on paper when you print it. An example of such editors is Word.

Text elements

Text consists of a set of characters represented by a certain encoding (KOI, UNICODE).

A character is any letter, number, punctuation mark, arithmetic operator, etc. entered using the keyboard and displayed on the monitor screen.

A word consists of any sequence of characters separated by spaces or punctuation marks on both sides.

A line is a sequence of characters that make up each line of a page.

Paragraph — The sequence of characters that is left until the Enter key is pressed.

Section — Separate text into separate sections using the Break command on the Insert tab.

Text editor capabilities

Almost all text editors help solve the following problems (Figure 1):

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All text editors perform the following functions:

- Moving the cursor,
- Working with the modes of writing characters over or between text,
- Working with a selected part of the text,
- Searching for words in the text and replacing them if necessary,
- Editor's reference book a brief help.

There are several types of text editors. Some work under the MS-DOS operating system, others under the Windows operating system. Examples of text editors running under the MS-DOS operating system include programs such as LATES, FOTON, PE2RUS, QEDIT, LEXICON, WD. Among the text editors running under the Windows operating system, programs such as WordPad, Microsoft Word, Works can be cited.

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Text editors can be single-window and multi-window. Single-window text editors can work with only one file at a time. When you open another file, the previous one is closed. Multi-window text editors can work with several files at the same time. This provides the user with a number of conveniences, namely, the ability to use text from one file in another file, and the ability to use data from several files at the same time.

When working with text in Windows, the text is printed on paper in the same way as it appears on the display.

First, let's understand the specific features of working with text in the Windows environment.

You can use the space or Tab keys to move the cursor to a certain place.

When a line is full, the cursor automatically moves to a new line. Therefore, the ENTER key is pressed only after the end of the paragraph (not after each line).

Punctuation marks (period, comma, colon, exclamation point, question mark) cannot be preceded by a space, only by one space after them. Otherwise, the next line may start with a punctuation mark.
